



## Getting Things Ready

The health and safety of you and your family is of utmost importance to us. Here is what we've done to make sure kids stay safe in the VKids building.

1. The building and its contents have been cleaned and professionally sanitized.
2. Mobile check in available.
3. Outdoor check in available.
4. Volunteers will escort your child to their classroom (except children who are two and under).
5. Handwashing education for all volunteers.
6. Volunteers will clean surfaces throughout the morning.

### Updated Check In Procedures

We're encouraging everyone to use the mobile check in option through the Shelby Membership App. You will be receiving an email invitation to Shelby beginning Friday, June 12. If you don't see this, please check your spam. If you haven't received this email by Monday, June 15 please contact Charity at [Charity@vineyardaugusta.org](mailto:Charity@vineyardaugusta.org).

When you arrive, there will be a table set up to the left of the VKids Building entrance with your child's printed name tag and your guardian tag. A volunteer will escort your child to their classroom. If you have a child two years old or under, you may escort your child to their room.

If you prefer not to use the mobile check in, we will have a check in table set up to the right of the VKids Building entrance. You will sign in, write your child's name tag and take a guardian tag. A volunteer will escort your child to their classroom.

### Updated Check Out Procedures

When service is over and you return to the Vkids building, we will have a table set up in front of the doors. Please give your guardian tag to the volunteer. The volunteer will enter the building and get your child/children for you.
